

Carolyn White Fore, PhD, has many years of leadership experience in a corporate environment with responsibility for multigenerational teams. During those years she saw firsthand the differences in the leadership styles of leaders from different generational groups. She wrote her doctoral dissertation on next-generation leadership, focusing on Millennials as leaders, and through her research explored how Millennial leaders describe leaders, leading, and what leadership means.
